PAJAMA DAY

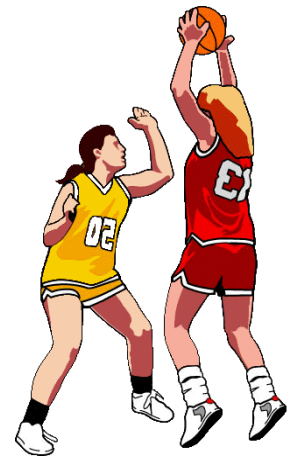

BASKETBALL RESULTS
