

School Resource Officer - Part Time

Job Description: The School Resource Officer provides security and maintains safety plans for the school. The School Resource Officer monitors the school campus, ensures best safety procedures are in place for potential threats, and conducts drills with students and staff. The School Resource Officer is the main security resource of the school and is a certified or retired police officer.

Responsibilities:

- Patrolling the school grounds, ensuring overall safety, viewing videos and security monitors, and watching for strangers or suspicious activity.
- Protecting the school and students against theft and property damage and assisting in medical emergencies.
- Conducting drills with students and staff
- Maintaining school safety plans and updating them as needed
- Ensuring best safety practices are in place for potential threats
- Supervising special events and directing foot and auto traffic, if necessary.
- Maintaining positive relationships and contact with students to promote Christian behavior.
- Working with counselor and support staff to assist students when referrals to service agencies are necessary, or to assist in conflict resolutions.

Requirements:

- Certification from a police academy
- First aid and CPR certified
- Patient attitude; even tempered
- Ability to counsel and interact with young children and teens
- Regular attendance in a local church
