FOOD DRIVE

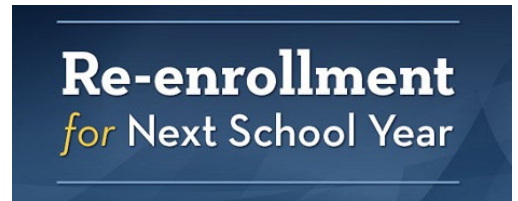

DID YOU ENROLL?

The enrollment period for all SCS families is open **now through January 19**. On January 22, open enrollment will begin, and we will begin offering seats to new families. For that reason, we encourage all current families to complete the re-enrollment process and/or submit new student applications prior to January 19.



Please use the following instructions to complete the re-enrollment process. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Hannah Jurius at hjurius@sussexchristianschool.org or 973-875-5595 ext. 232.

- **Returning Students:** Last week, you should have received an email from admissions@sussexchristianschool.org with the subject line "Begin Re-enrollment". That email contained a link that allows you to create an online enrollment account. After your account is created, you will be able to complete re-enrollment for each child in your family following the steps outlined [here](#) and in the attached PDF.

A Welcome email was also sent to the mother in most families. Note that you will receive an email for each child in the family. If you'd like us to switch which parent is responsible for enrollment for your family OR if neither parent received the welcome email today, please email Hannah Jurius. Be sure to check your spam if you didn't see the email come through! *Please note: You will need to input information separately for each child. We recognize that this may become time-consuming for larger families, and we apologize for the inconvenience. Next year, all this information will be saved for you, and it will be a much quicker process!*

- **Current Families - New Students:** If you would like to enroll a new student at SCS, for example a new preschool or kindergarten student, please email the office for the appropriate application form and return it to Hannah Jurius in the Admissions Office (by email, mail, or in-person) **no later than January 19**. If you'd like to enroll a new student in grades 1-8, you must also submit the child's report cards from this year and last year and provide the School Recommendation Form to his or her current teacher or principal. After the application is complete and we accept the student, we will provide you with a link to complete the registration forms online to complete his or her registration information. Again, please contact the office with any questions, and we will help you complete the process. Thank you!
