#### Dear Parents and Guardians:

My name is Naomi Mason, and I am the school counselor here at SCS. I am looking forward to having the opportunity to work with many of your children in various ways at different times throughout the school year. I may work directly with your child/children through their classes if/when invited in by the classroom teacher, individually if requested by you, a teacher, and/or your child, and through skills group sessions.

Through different skills groups, I can better support the spiritual, social, and emotional development of students, which has a positive influence on academic development and success. These small groups will focus on social skills, coping skills, problem solving skills, and character traits such as respect, empathy, kindness and more. We will meet once a week during the school day for approximately 30 minutes, most likely during lunch time.

Your children will have the opportunity to learn new skills and behaviors through applying scripture and discussing ideas, feelings, behaviors, attitudes, and opinions. The children will participate in a variety of activities relating to the group topic. These activities may include drawing, role-playing, relaxation exercises, board games, and practicing new behaviors.

As the parent/guardian, you can always feel free to contact me to discuss your child and his or her growth in the group. However, because counseling is based on a trusting relationship between the counselor and the students, the leader will keep the information shared by the members confidential unless school policy and/or ethical responsibilities require disclosure. These situations are quite rare and only relevant information will be shared if such occasion arises.

In order for your child to participate in a group, I will need your written permission. Please complete the attached permission form and send it back to school with your child to turn in to their classroom teacher. #### Dear SCS Families:

We are pleased to offer instrumental lessons to children in grades 4 – 8 this year! Lessons are available for the beginner player as well as for those who are experienced with their instrument.

Your child can choose from a variety of instruments and will have one 30-minute lesson on Monday afternoons in alternating time slots each week. Lessons will start on September 30th. The price for each student is \$300 for the year. Payments should be made directly to me via check, cash or Venmo. Full payment is due by September 30 or can be broken into 8 installments with the first installment of \$37.50 due by October 1st and the remaining 7 installments of \$37.50 each due on the first Monday of each month.

This fee does not cover the cost of the instrument. Please reach out to a music store as soon as possible to find information on renting or buying an instrument. We recommend using The Music Den in Randolph (973.927.5800) or Sussex County Music (973.875.8717). If your child is interested in percussion, we have many different percussion instruments at the school, but it would be helpful to purchase a practice pad and drumsticks to practice at home. Instruments for students to choose from:

- Woodwinds: Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone
- Brass: Trumpet, Trombone, French Horn
- Percussion

Students taking lessons will also be a part of our SCS Band. Band practice will begin during the  $2^{nd}$  marking period as part of the students' weekly schedule at no cost to the parents.
