BASKETBALL REGISTRATION OPEN

Registration for the upcoming basketball season is now open! Students in grades 5 through 8 are eligible to join our teams. There will be a team for the boys and a team for the girls. If there are enough players, we will also break into a JV and Varsity team. Registration packets were given to all students today who expressed interest in joining the team. **Registrations will be accepted through Thursday, October 31.**

Practices will begin mid-November. Games are already listed on our website calendar; practice days and times will be updated in the next several days.

Two checks are required to be submitted with paperwork: a \$125 registration fee made payable to Sussex Christian School and a separate check for \$50 to be held as a uniform security deposit.

Please remember that your child must have a current NJ Sport Physical on file in order to participate. If your child's physical is over 90 days old, you will need to complete the Sport History Update form.

Note to Parents of Soccer Players: If your child is on this year's soccer team, you DO NOT need to complete the following forms as I already have them from soccer.
