


WINTER'S ON THE WAY – PLEASE DRESS APPROPRIATELY!

To order Candygram(s): Fill out the form below and send in money with your child.


Students will give their orders to their teachers and the Candygrams will be delivered at lunch within a few days. They can be purchased for friends, teachers, or given to children by their parents!


