#### 2025-2026 CLOSED ENROLLMENT PERIOD

This year has been another great year for enrollment at SCS, with so many new families joining the school! Preschool 3, Preschool 4 (full day), Kindergarten, 3<sup>rd</sup> grade, and 4<sup>th</sup> grades are all full classes, and we have limited seats available in several other grades. Praise the Lord!

**Re-enrollment** for Next School Year

With the number of new families already reaching out with interest in enrolling in the 2025-2026 school year, we will be offering a <u>Closed Enrollment period for ALL GRADES</u> to our current SCS families from January 6 to January 20, 2025. A link to re-enroll your child(ren) for the 2025-2026 academic school year will be emailed to all current families on Monday, January 6 along with instructions. You will access the FACTS Enrollment portal using your existing credentials. If you do not re-enroll your child(ren) by January 20, 2025, we cannot guarantee your child a seat in a full class even if you have other children attending the school. Seats will be reserved in the order the applications are completed. If you have a new child you wish to enroll, please contact the office for instructions. New Student Applications for current SCS families are also due January 20, 2025, for existing SCS families.

On January 21, open enrollment will start. New families who have completed the admissions process will be offered any remaining seats available in classes they are applying for. Current SCS families re-enrolling after the January 20 deadline will be offered any remaining seats in the order that applications are received. Once classes are filled, late registrants will be put in a wait pool until a seat becomes available or a new class is added to accommodate the growing population.

Registered families will, as always, have a two-week grace period after the publication of the next year's tuition rates to withdraw.
