155 BOOK FAIR

OEL is again hosting an 155 Book Fair! It will be held March 3 – 7 during the "Love of Reading Week. 155 is a Christian business that works with schools to provide quality, age-appropriate literature to the next generation of readers. This book fair has been hugely successful for us in the past! Here is how the week will work:



Wish List Days - Monday and Tuesday, March 3 & 4: Each class has signed up for a time for students to visit the Book Fair and create a wish-list to bring home to their parents.

Purchase Days – Wednesday and Thursday, March 5 & 6: Each class has signed up for a time for students to go to the Book Fair to purchase books. Payments can be cash, credit card or check (made to Sussex Christian School - OEL).

Parent Day – Friday, March 7: Parents will have the opportunity to visit the book fair and make purchases. Parents should enter school through the gym lobby – not the main entrance.

If you would like to shop with your child, teachers have asked that you come on the following days/times. Enter through the gym entrance and we will get your child for you.

- Preschool 3: Thursday, March 6 between 11 am and 11:45 am
- Preschool 4 Half Day: Wednesday, March 5 between 11:45 am and 12:25 pm.
- Kindergarten: Wednesday, March 5 between 1:50 pm and 2:30 pm.
- 1st Grades: Friday, March 7 between 8:50 am and 12 pm
- 2nd Grade: Friday, March 7 between 9:30 am and 10:10 am
- 3rd Grade: Friday, March 7 between 8:50 am and 9:30 am
- 4th Grade: Friday, March 7 between 11:45 am and 12 pm
- 5th Grade: Friday, March 7 anytime between 10:20 am and 11 am

Important Notes:

- There is a large selection of books and many copies of each one. If there are any books that are "oversold"; we will order them and deliver them to your students' classroom in about 2 weeks from the book fair end date.
- "Last Copy" books will be labeled with the student's name who wants it, and it will be sent home with that student on Friday, March 7. We need to hold onto the book until the end of the fair so others can see it and have it ordered for them if they want it.
- Forty (40%) of profits go towards books for the teachers' classrooms and library. In the past we have been able to fulfill all teachers' wish lists and most of the library wish lists.
